Breakfast and Lunch

We will be serving breakfast and lunch to all students attending summer school at no cost.

Transportation

Bus pickup and drop-off from home is available from June 16th to July 3rd. If your student requires busing, please inform the Elementary office as soon as possible. Your bus driver will communicate the times shortly before the session begins on June 16th, 2025.

Attendance

Please ensure your student attends all registered classes. Supplies are purchased based on registration, and "drop-outs" and "no-shows" prevent other students from attending and increase costs for the school district.

We kindly remind all parents and students that attending summer school is a privilege that should be respected.

After School Plans

Please inform the office of your student's default after school plan for summer school and any daily changes.

This ensures a safe and smooth transition to the correct location.

Class Fees

Some of our classes/offerings have a fee associated with them. Please submit all payments to the Frederic Elementary School or pay via Infinite Campus under the Fees section.

Class Enrollment

Classes operate on a first-come, first-served basis. A class requires a minimum of 6 students and is capped at 25 students, unless noted. The class will become unavailable if either criteria is met.

Out of District Students

Families who do not live in the Frederic school district or are not currently open enrolled at Frederic School District will be charged \$75 per student, per week to attend. The family maximum will be \$225 per week.

Enrollment will be capped per class. Frederic students will receive priority when registering for classes.

Transportation is only provided for resident students. Classes with associated fees will still apply.

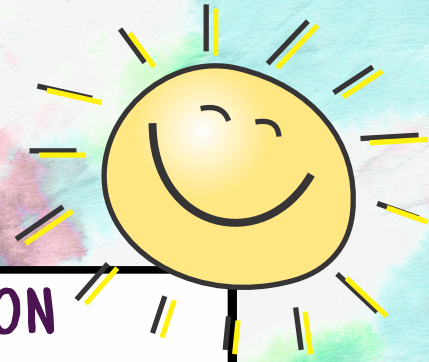

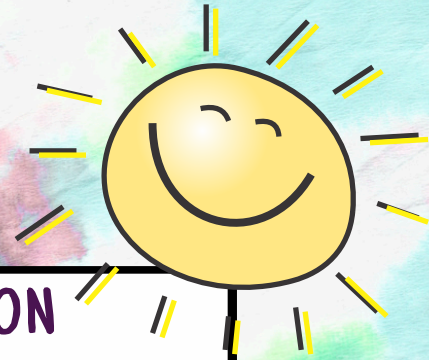

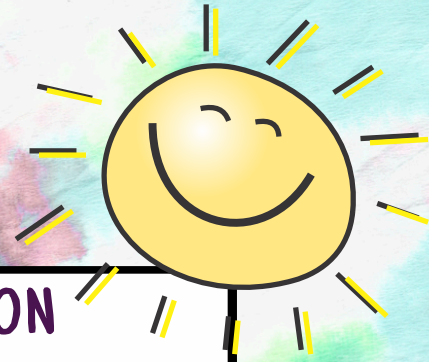


CLASS	GRADES	DESCRIPTION

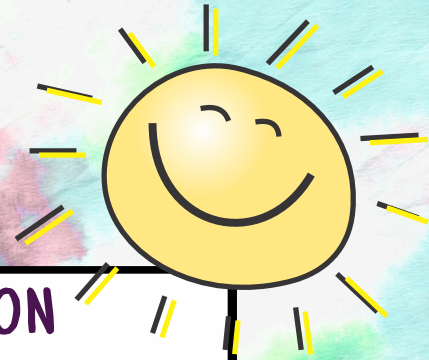

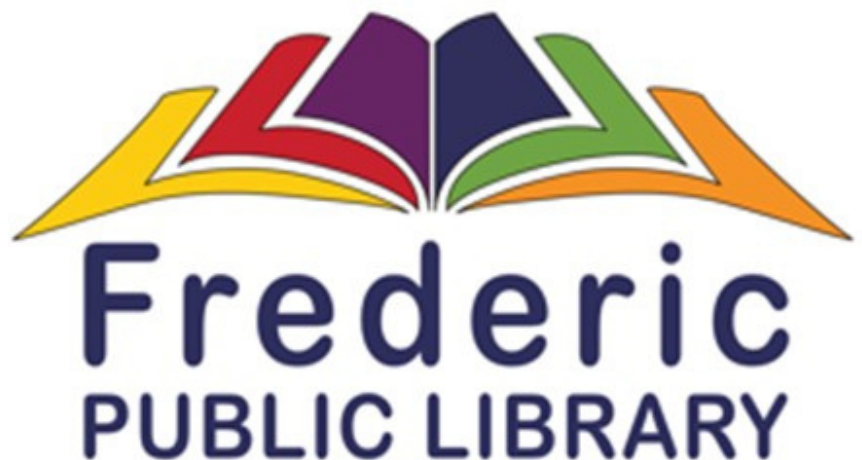

JUNIOR LIFEGUARDING SWIMMING COURSE

Recommended for students ages 11-14, who have passed American Red Cross Level 4 swimming lessons.

The Junior Lifeguarding Course is to build a foundation of knowledge and skill for future lifeguards. Participants are not required to master or perfectly execute the skills, but learn techniques and build stamina. The course does not certify participants in lifeguarding, first aid, CPR or AED use.

30 HOUR COURSE:

July 7th-11th from 7:50am - 1:00pm
July 14th - 18th from 7:50am - 1:00pm

Prerequisites to enter Junior Lifeguarding is as follows:

- Swim the front crawl for 25 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side
- Swim the breaststroke for 25 yards continuously while using a pull, breathe, kick, and glide sequence.

Students will complete the Water Competency Sequence:

- Step into the water and fully submerge.
- Maintain position for one minute by treading water, floating, or a combination of the two.
- Rotate one full turn and orient to the exit.
- Level off and swim on the front or back 25 yards.
- Exit without using a ladder or steps.

All classes are from the Learn To Swim Program by the American Red Cross and taught by certified Water Safety instructors.

Parents/guardians must drop off and pick up from the Elementary school. School bus transportation is provided from the Elementary school to the Unity pool.

LEVEL	AGE	DESCRIPTION
PRE-LEVEL 1	AGE 4-5	<i>Classes take place in the kiddie pool with progression to the big pool. Swimmers will work on entering and exiting the pool independently, submerging mouth and lowering bubbles, front and back gliding with assistance, and combining arm and leg motions on the front and back with assistance.</i>
LEVEL 1 INTRO TO WATER SKILLS	AGE 5 & UP	<i>Basic swim and safety skills will be performed with assistance in the big pool. Swimmers will work on bobbing, retrieving submerged objects, front and back glides, combined and simultaneous arm and leg actions on the front and back with assistance.</i>
LEVEL 2 FUNDAMENTAL AQUATIC SKILLS	AGE 6 & UP	<i>Basic swim and safety skills will be performed without assistance in the big pool. Swimmers will work on submerging, front and back glides, combined, alternating, and simultaneous arm and leg actions on the front and back without assistance. Swimmers must perform the exit skill of swimming on the front for 5 body lengths, rolling to their back, floating for 15 seconds, rolling to their front, and then continuing swimming for 5 body lengths to move onto level 3.</i>
LEVEL 3 STROKE DEVELOPMENT	AGE 7 & UP OR COMPLETION OF LEVEL 2	<i>Swimmers will focus on flutter, scissor, breaststroke, and dolphin kicks. They will focus on increasing their distances of the Front Crawl, Elementary backstroke, and Back Crawl. Introduction to diving.</i>
LEVEL 4 STROKE IMPROVEMENT	SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF LEVEL 3	<i>Swimmer should already be able to: swim front and back crawl 25 yards. Swimmers will work on rotary breathing, freestyle, backstroke, elementary backstroke, scissor kicks, side strokes, whip kicks, breast strokes, treading water with modified scissor kicks, and diving from a kneeling position.</i>
